



IDA Monthly report- February 2017 for mobile dentistry clinic in Aleppo Region, Northern Syria”

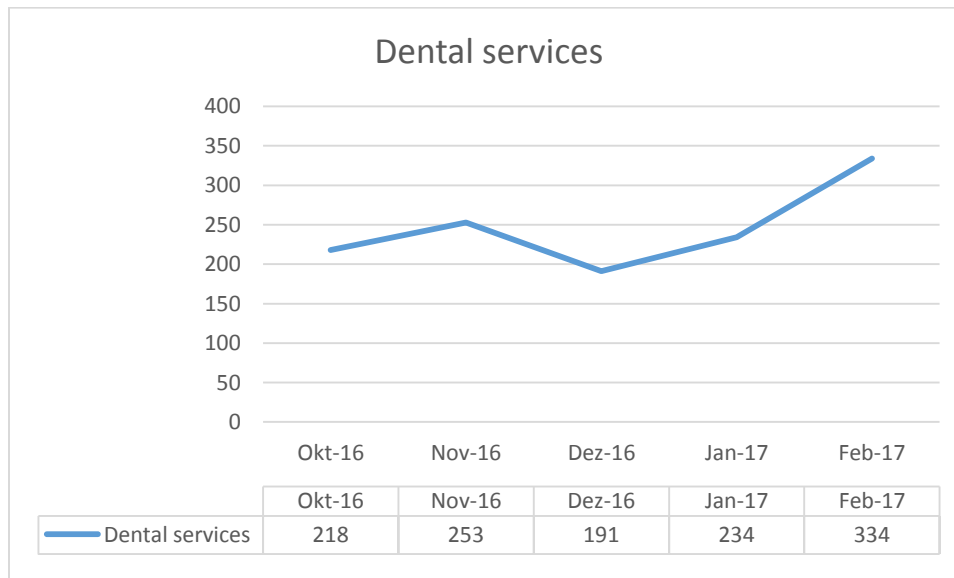
This report is a brief summary of the work in the mobile dentistry clinic in northern rural Aleppo camps. The project started in October 2016 with the support of Green Helmets organization.

The project is composed of mobile truck fully equipped to provide dental services for IDPs in the camps. It provides the service alternately in both Al-Rayyan and Shamarekh camps.

Area of operation	Aleppo governorate
Project facilities	One mobile dentistry clinic.
Location	Al-Rayyan and Shamarekh camps in northern rural Aleppo.
Reporting month	February - 2017

Services in numbers:

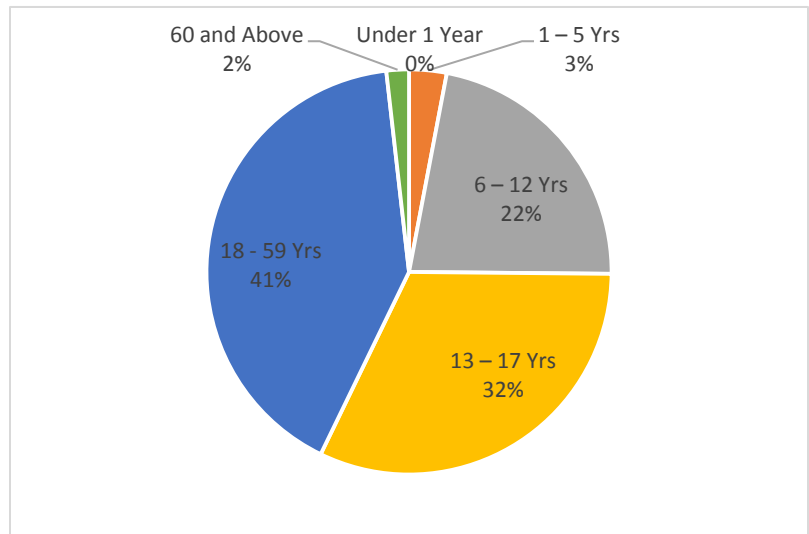
- The total number of services provided from October 2016 to February 2017 is **1230**.
- The beneficiaries in January are divided as: **36 % males and 64 % females**.
- The chart below shows a comparison between the number of the services provided in October, November, December 2016, January 2017 and February 2017:





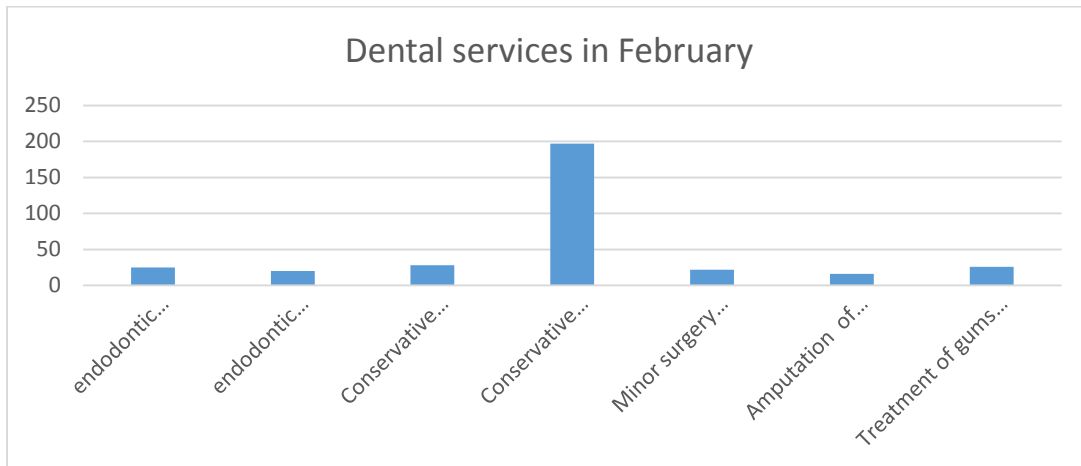
- The age categories for these beneficiaries are:

- ✓ 0 % children under 1 year
- ✓ 3 % children between 1-5 years
- ✓ 22 % children between 6-12 years
- ✓ 32 % children between 13-17 years
- ✓ 41 % between 18-59 years
- ✓ 2 % above 60 years



The services provided in the mobile dentistry clinic include endodontic therapy, conservative therapy and minor surgery.
