



## IDA Monthly report June - 2017 for mobile dentistry clinic in Aleppo Region, Northern Syria”

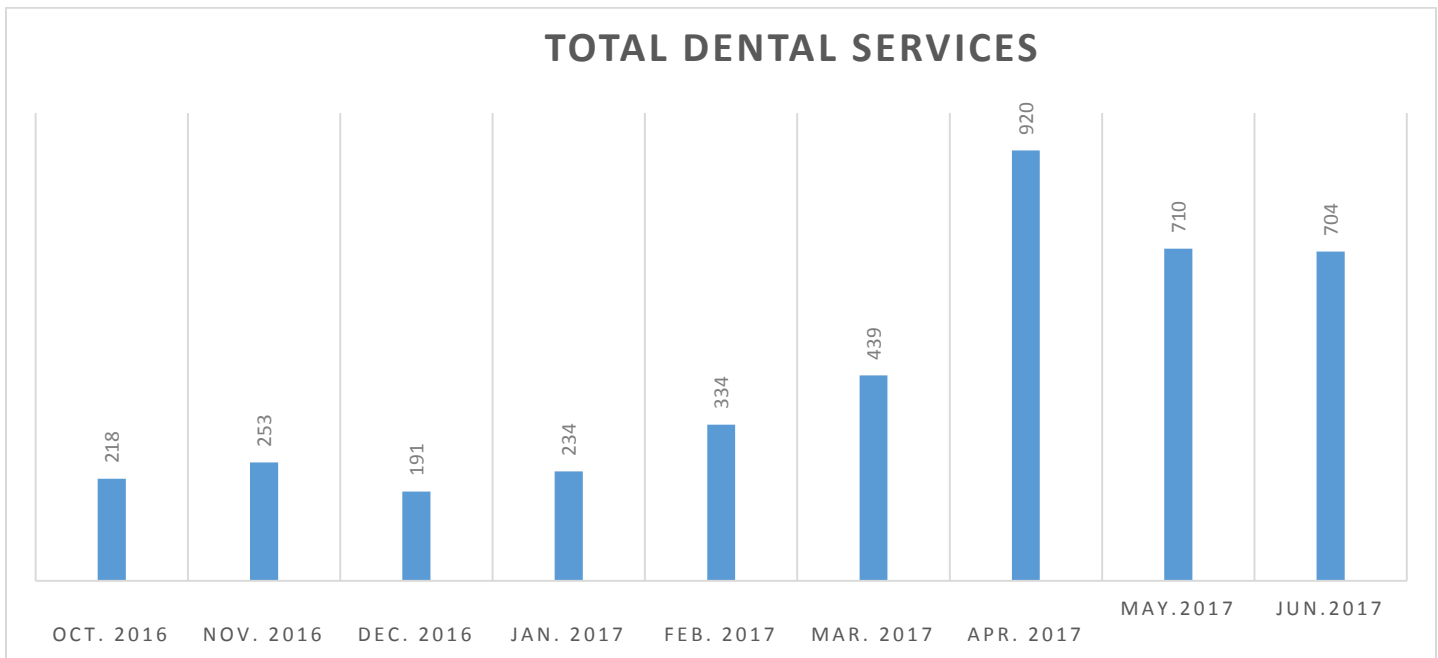
This report is a brief summary of the work in the mobile dentistry clinic in northern rural Aleppo camps. The project started in October 2016 with the support of Green Helmets organization.

The project is composed of mobile truck fully equipped to provide dental services for IDPs in the camps. It provides the service alternately in Shamarekh camps.

Reporting month	June – 2017

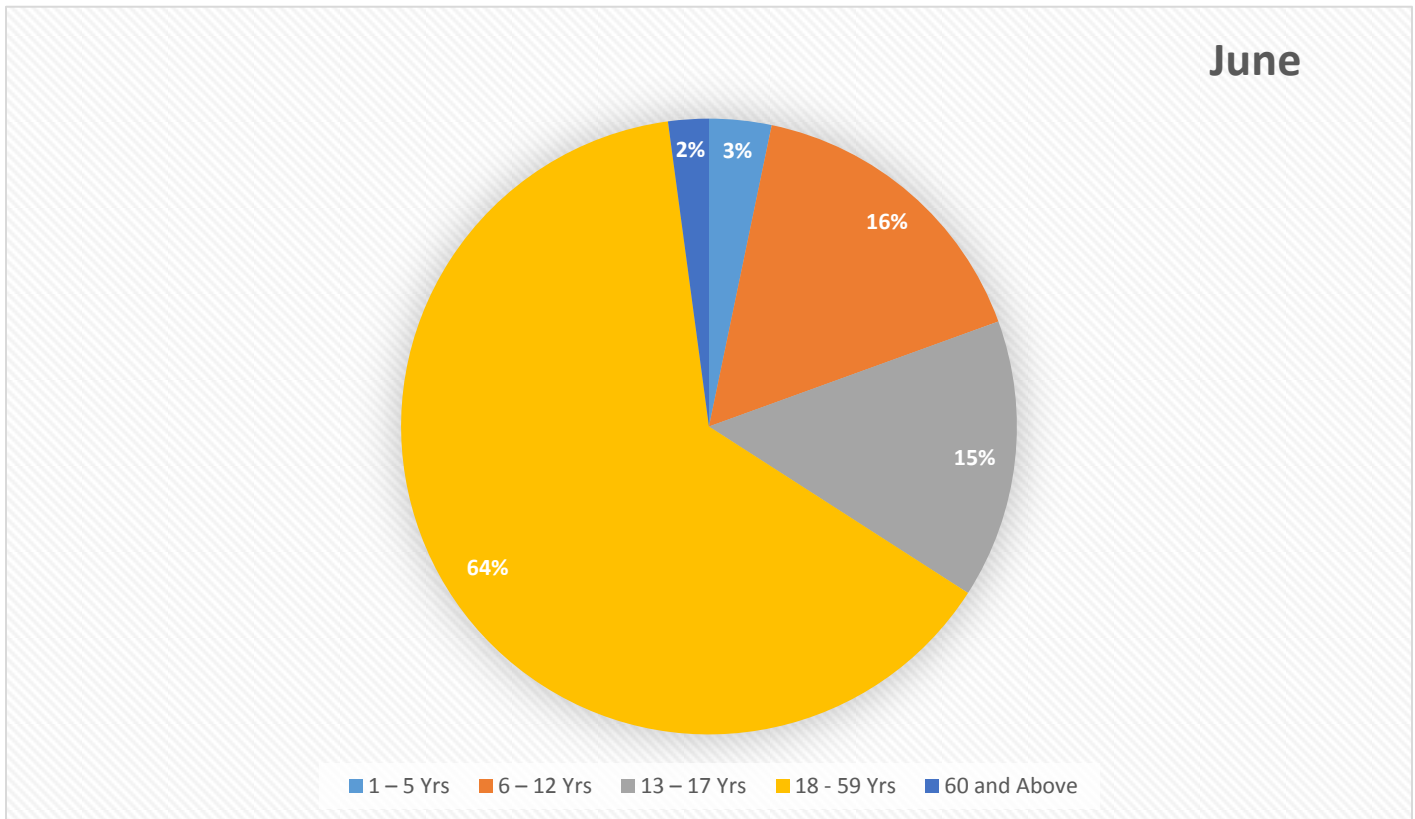
### Services in numbers:

- The total number of services provided from October 2016 to June 2017 is **4003**.
- The beneficiaries in June are divided as: **40.2 % males and 59.8 % females**.
- The chart below shows a comparison between the number of the services provided in October, November, December 2016, January 2017 and February 2017, March 2017, April 2017, May 2017, June 2017.





- The age categories for these beneficiaries are:

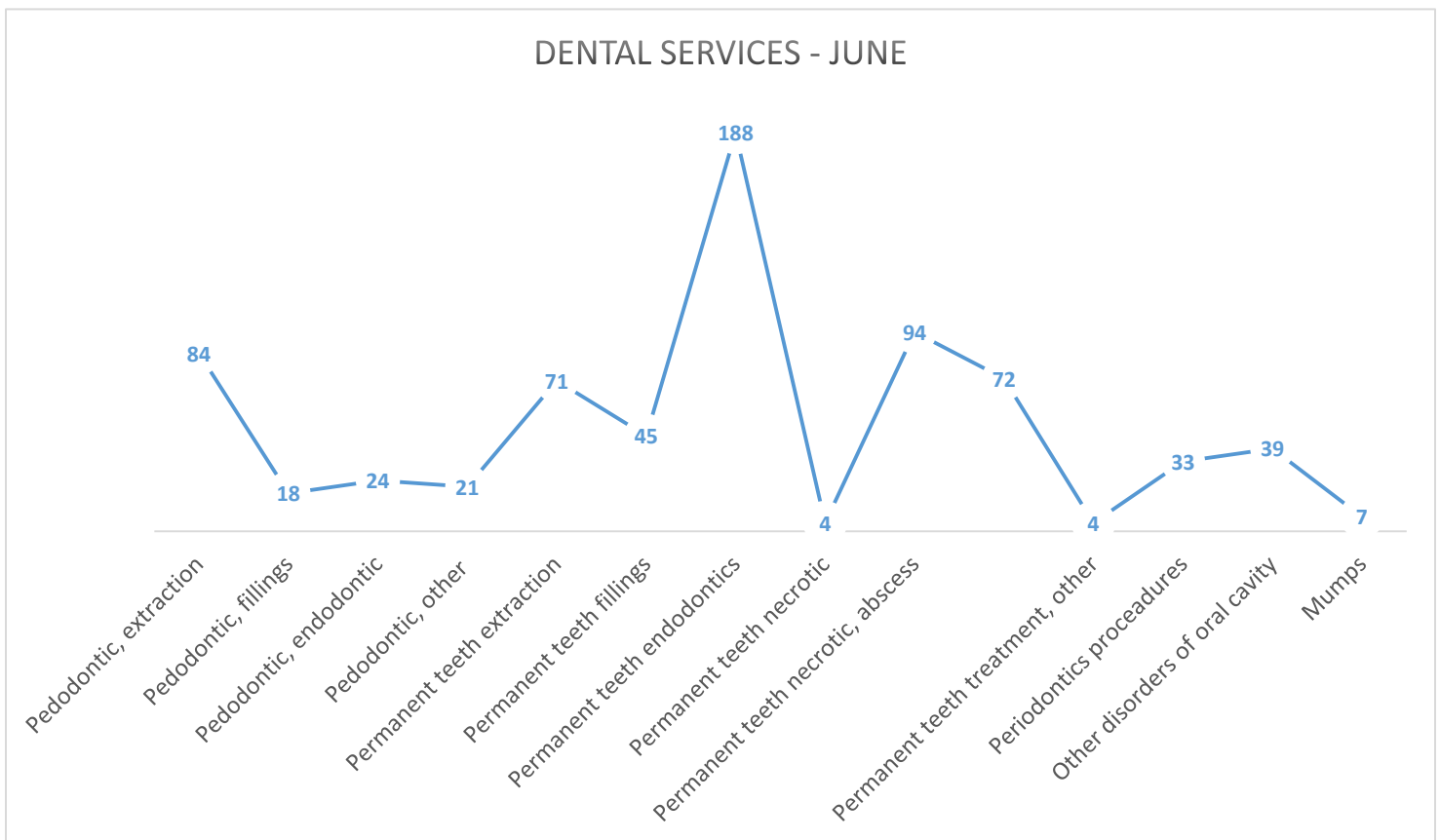


- ✓ 2 % children between 1-5 years
- ✓ 16 % children between 6-12 years
- ✓ 15 % children between 13-17 years
- ✓ 64 % between 18-59 years
- ✓ 3 % above 60 years



The services provided in the mobile dentistry clinic include endodontic therapy, conservative therapy and minor surgery.
